| colour mixing | creating a new colour by combining other colours |
| secondary | a colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours |
| tertiary | a colour that is a result of mixing and equal amount of a primary and secondary colour |
| tints | a shade or variety of a colour |
| shades | a slight degree of difference between colours. |
| collage | a piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces <br> of paper or fabric on to a backing. |
| colour-field | is characterized primarily by large fields of flat, solid colour spread across or stained into <br> the canvas creating areas of unbroken surface and a flat picture plane. |
| drip painting | is a form of abstract art in which paint is dripped or poured on to the canvas. |
