Teachers have found Class Dojo a wonderful way to communicate with parents and are keen to keep using the platform to share events, class updates and for any quick messages from home.

Should your child be absent from school though, please could parents contact the school office, either through phoning and leaving a message or by email. This will ensure all of the registers are up to date and any meals can be cancelled, if necessary.

The senior leadership team and governors must consider the well-being of staff and ensure they protect their work-life balance so please be mindful that staff are advised not to interact with Dojo outside their working hours (some are able to do this but it is at their discretion). If you have a number of things to discuss with the class teacher, it is always better to book in a time, after school to meet (rather than using Class Dojo).
