Nasal flu vaccination - Electronic consent

As last year the Immunisation Team will be offering the Flu vaccination to **all children up to the age of 18.** This will take place between October - December 2019 across Wiltshire/BaNES/Swindon and as last year the consent will need to be completed electronically.

In order to provide electronic consent for your child's Flu vaccination, please access the consent portal via the following link:

We would like to request that consent is provided as soon as possible as the link closes 7-14 days prior to the session in school. This link is secure, please **carefully** select your child's school from the drop down menu and this will ensure that the consent is in the right place. Full details and information to assist you in completing the consent is detailed on the portal including full FAQ's, patient information and contact details should you wish to speak to a nurse regarding the nasal vaccination.
