Flu Immunisations

Thank you to parents for kindly chasing information regarding these vaccinations. A date is now set.

Nurses from Virgin care will visit the school on November 11th to administer the NASAL Flu Vaccination. Please see the letter below from Virgin Care explaining how to provide consent for your child to be vaccinated. ONLY children with completed permissions will be vaccinated. Please follow the link to sign your child up.

Your child is due to be in Reception to Year 6 from September 2020 and they are therefore eligible for a Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination.

It is anticipated that this will be delivered in schools between October 2020 to December 2020, this will be administered adhering to all up to date Infection Control, PPE and social distancing guidance at the time.

Flu vaccination is one of the most effective interventions we have to reduce pressure on the health and social care system which is going to be more important than ever this year. For this reason, it is essential we deliver the vaccine to as many children as possible to prevent the spread of infection to those most at risk in society.

In light of the above we are expecting demand to be high and therefore we urge you to follow the below link to consent to your child's vaccination now. Even if you do not want your child to receive this vaccination, please complete the consent form stating "no" consent. You will also find answers to your FAQ's on this link.
