Knowledge Outcomes:

Pupils are taught to:

- recall some of the main points of the Easter Story.
- Understand the events of the Holy Week.
- Understand God's message to the people.
- Use the right names for things that are special to Christians.
- Talk about what is important to them and other people.
- Understand the importance of every one.
- Understand the message behind the parables.
- Sequence a story.
- Understand how people behave and act.
- Understand how this message can help them live their lives.
- Think about how to apply this message to their own lives.

Learning Journey:

- Can I retell the Christian Easter Story?
- Can I recall knowledge about Jesus' birth, some parables he taught, how he changed the lives of the people he met, his death and resurrection?
- How did he lead his life?
- What are the parables of the lost coin and the lost sheep?
- Can I explain why the characters acted as they did?
- Can I say what the message behind the story is and understand how I can apply this message to my own life.
- What is the parable of the mustard seed and the message it gives?

Wider Curriculum:

Links to collective worship and the stories told by Jesus to his followers and others, with links to our Christian Values. Children have the opportunity to think about the messages given, how it relates to them and the way they live their lives.
